My Mum's Baby and Kids Market do not hold responsibility for any accidents\spills of any liquids such a hot or cold drinks.

All food is purchased at the buyers own risk and My Mum's Baby and Kids Market do not hold responsibility for any allergies/reactions which may occur.

### **Health and Safety -**

Health and safety is of paramount importance to My Mum's Baby and Kids Market and we look to promote high standards at each event.

Children who attend the event should be supervised during the event, and it is the responsibility of the parent/carer to maintain the child's safety and wellbeing at all times during the event.

All people who enter the venue do so at their own risk.

### **Baby Changing Area**

### **Security –**

### **Purchasing -**

### **Prams and Pushchairs**

Buggies and strollers sold in the UK should comply with British Standard BS 7409. The pushchair itself must display the British Standard label and detail the year it was made, ie BS 7409 2008.

This law applies to the sale of second hand buggies/strollers as well as new and buyers should ensure before purchasing that :

The item is of good construction and stability. The item has a built-in 5-point harness, older models may have a 3-point harness. The brakes should function properly and the manufacturer's instruction manual is included.

### **Car Seats**

For health & safety reasons it is recommended that you do not purchase a second hand car seat/infant carrier as you can never be sure that it hasn't been involved in a crash.

### **Electrical Items**

If you wish to buy a second hand electrical item such as a steam steriliser or mains powered bottle warmer, then you should consider the following:

For health & safety reasons the law states that all second hand electrical items must be tested properly by a competent person before being sold and must include the manufacturer's instruction manual.

It is recommended that buyers ask the seller to prove the item is in full working order by asking them to test the item before purchasing on the day of the sale.
